ABS	A Candidate who fails to appear for an Examination with a valid reason will be awarded an 'ABS' grade.
IVA	A Candidate who fails to appear for an Examination with an invalid reason shall be deemed to have failed the module and will be awarded an 'IVA' grade.
Suppl	A Candidate who fails one or more modules in the semester examination may be permitted to take a Supplementary Examination.
GPA	Grade Point Average
cGPA	Cumulative Grade Point Average

Modular Credit (MC) refers to the number of credits or units assigned to a module to indicate the number of expected workload and contact hours of that module

Cumulative Grade Point Average formula:

Sum (Module grade point x modular credit point assigned to Module x Level weightage of modules) divide by Sum (modular credit assigned to modules x Level weightage of modules)

Transfer	The Grade Point of any module transferred from the previous Major/Degree Programme to the new Major/Degree Programme shall be retained and be included in the cumulative GPA in the new Major/Degree Programme.
Credit	The modular credit of this module is transferred. The Grade Point of this module will not be included in the cGPA
Transfer	calculation.

In the Bachelor degree programme, students are required to participate in the Discovery Year programme to broaden their knowledge and give invaluable experience in a real world setting. This is normally undertaken in the third year of study, in the 5th and 6th semesters of a candidature. The Discovery Year options are as follows:

- DS-3001 Study Abroad Programme (SAP)
- DC-3001 Community Outreach Programme (COP)
- DW-3001 Internship Programme
- DI-3001 Innovation or Incubation Projects

Academic Status:

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Active	the status accorded to a student in a semester when the student has achieved a cumulative Grade Point
	Average of 1.5 or greater in the previous semester
Probation	the status accorded to a student in a semester when the student has failed to obtain a cumulative Grade Point
	Average of at least 1.5 in the previous semester, and/or failure to declare a Major before the commencement of
	the 4 th semester and/or failure to register at least twelve (12) modular credits in any one (1) semester

AWARD OF DEGREE

A student may be awarded the degree of Undergraduate if he/she at least has maintained a cGPA of 1.5 and fulfilled all the requirements of the Regulations governing the degree for which he/she is a candidate. The Class of Bachelor's Degree awarded is as follows:

- First Class Honours
- Upper Second Class Honours
- Lower Second Class Honours
- Third Class Honours
- Pass Degree
