

## **1. STUDENTS ON TRANSFER CREDIT – All Transfer Credit students**

## Level of studies:

- <u>Undergraduate students</u>: Two years minimum of studies in business/social science, ideally in the last year of their undergraduate programme with the equivalent of 120 ECTS credits in Business.
- Postgraduate students:

Students must have obtained the level "Bachelor Degree" (BA, *Licenciatura*, etc.) or at least the equivalent of 180 ECTS credits in Business Studies.

<ul> <li>Fully completed application form signed by the candidate and the Home University.</li> <li>Official transcripts for the entire education of the student at the home university (translated into English if the transcripts are not in English, French, German, Spanish or Italian) with the official stamp of your home institution.</li> <li>CV (in English).</li> <li>Motivation letter (in English).</li> <li>A copy of the identity page of your passport.</li> <li>One passport photo attached to the application.</li> <li>An official certificate provided by your home institution certifying the level of your oral and written business English language skills, equivalent to IBT TOEFL = 79.</li> <li>If electives taught in French are chosen, an official certificate provided by your home institution certifying the level of your oral and written business French language skills is required (B2 level minimum required).</li> <li>A list of courses you wish to take.</li> </ul>
The level of English is left up to evaluation of the home university (we ask the home institution to provide a certificate confirming a B2 level in English – or equivalent TOEFL, which is sufficient to take classes at ESC Rennes). All or most classes are conducted in English, therefore students are expected to have a sufficient command of English language to be able to understand, make oral presentations, write reports and exams etc. <b>China requires students to have a minimum of</b> <u>6.5</u> <b>IELTS in order to obtain their visa</b> (equivalent to TOEFL: IBT = 79, computer based = 213, paper based = 550, TOEIC = 750, IELTS = 6.5).

## 2. STUDENTS ON DOUBLE DEGREE – All Double Degree students

## Level of studies:

- International Bachelor Programme in Management (IBPM): Students in the last year of their bachelor studies in business.
- <u>Master Programme</u>: Students must have obtained the level "Bachelor Degree" (BA, *Licenciatura*, etc.) plus meet the specific requirements of each programme.
- <u>Master in Management (Grande Ecole programme)</u>: Please refer to the specific exchange agreement.

Application Procedure	<ul> <li>Fully completed application form signed by the candidate and the Home University.</li> <li>Official transcripts for the entire education of the student at the home university (translated into English if the transcripts are not in English, French, German, Spanish or Italian) with the official stamp of your home institution.</li> <li>CV (in English).</li> <li>Motivation letter (in English).</li> <li>A copy of the identity page of your passport.</li> <li>One passport photo attached to the application.</li> <li>A copy of your official TOEFL, TOEIC or IELTS score report.</li> </ul>
Language requirements	<ul> <li>One of the following English language tests is required (except for native English speakers):</li> <li>TOEFL: IBT = 79, computer based = 213, paper based = 550.</li> <li>TOEIC = 750.</li> <li>IELTS = 6.5.</li> <li>No French test required unless electives in French are chosen (B2 level minimum).</li> </ul>

Application deadlines	Fall semester $\rightarrow$ 30th May, 2016.Spring semester $\rightarrow$ 21st October, 2016.
