Where is it?

The twin city of Arnhem-Nijmegen (18km between) is in the east of the Netherlands, close to the German border. Arnhem Business School is located in Arnhem, about 1.5 hours by car from Amsterdam.

Campuses

Arnhem Business School is located in the Netherlands, a small, highly developed country in Western Europe. The school is situated in an important region for international trade. The region surrounding Arnhem and Nijmegen is one of Europe's prime economic locations.

Arnhem Business School (ABS) is a faculty of HAN University of Applied Sciences, which has campuses in Arnhem and Nijmegen. HAN University has a total enrolment of about 30,000 students, of which around 8,000 study at ABS. Over a1000 of them are enrolled in one of our international courses. You have the opportunity to join us for one or two exchange semesters, during which time you can experience the practical ABS learning environment and follow a typically Dutch course: Dutch Culture, Language and Society. The language of instruction at Arnhem Business School is English. HAN University of Applied Sciences offers courses in either Dutch or English.

How many credits must exchange students take?

Full time students take 8-12 hours of seminar-based classes a week, for a total of about 30 ECTS.

What are the semester dates?

First Semester: End of August – Middle of January

Second Semester: End of January – Beginning of July

Is Student Housing available?

Yes. Arnhem Business School will assist students with furnished accommodation.

What are the Visa requirements?

Can exchange students work while studying overseas?

No. Permit procedures take over six months, which is longer than most exchange placements.

What Health and Travel Insurance requirements do you need to consider?

Health and Travel insurance is compulsory. Most students use an insurance called International Passport for Students (IPS) : <http://www.ace-ips-nl.com/>. We strongly advise that you take out suitable travel insurance to cover yourself against loss or theft of your belongings in transit & during your travels.
