<b>Accommodation</b>	There is no on-campus accommodation at ISC Paris, but we help students find private accommodation (either in private students' residences, studios, rooms with a family or shared flats in central Paris).

Integration - buddy evenings:</b> have your own "ISC student angel" <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Day trips out: experience a weekend in a French place of interest, such as "Mont Saint Michel", "the vineyard route" and more.</li> <li>- "Erasmus Parties": parties for international students</li> </ul> </li> <li><b>3.
