



## 1 - Institutional Grading scale

18-20	Exceptional
16-17	Excellent
14-15	Very good
12-13	Good
10-11	Average
8-9	Just Sufficient
Below 8	Fail

If the mark for a subject is more than 10/20, they get the credits. If the weighted average is > 10/20, they get 30 credits per semester even if some subjects are under 10.

## 2 - ECTS Grading scale (European Credit Transfer System)

ECTS Grade	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
Α	10	EXCELLENT - outstanding performance with only minor errors
В	25	VERY GOOD - above the average standard but with some errors
С	30	GOOD - generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	25	SATISFACTORY - fair but with significant shortcomings
E	10	SUFFICIENT - performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	-	FAIL - some more work required before the credit can be awarded
F	-	FAIL - considerable further work is required

## **ECTS** credits:

1 full academic year = 60 credits 1 semester = 30 credits 1 term/trimester = 20 credits
