ANNEX 1: Application Procedure (Transfer Credit students)

LEVEL OF STUDIES:

- Undergraduate students: 2 years minimum of studies in business/social science, ideally in the last year of their undergraduate programme (with the equivalent of 120 ECTS credits in Business).
- Postgraduate students: must have obtained the level "Bachelor Degree" (BA, *Licenciatura*, etc.) or at least the equivalent of 180 ECTS credits in Business Studies.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS	<p>The level of English is left up to evaluation of the home university (we ask the home institution to provide a certificate confirming a <u>B2 level in English</u> – or equivalent TOEFL/IELTS/TOEIC, which is sufficient to take classes at <i>Rennes SB</i>).</p> <p>All or most classes are conducted in English, therefore students are expected to have a sufficient command of English language to be able to understand, make oral presentations, write reports and exams etc. China requires students to have a minimum of 6.5 IELTS in order to obtain their visa (equivalent to TOEFL: IBT = 79, computer based = 213, paper based = 550, TOEIC = 750, IELTS = 6.5).</p>

Bilateral agreement signed between Rennes School of Business and the Host Institution is required in order to apply for a Double Degree programme.

LEVEL OF STUDIES:

- International Bachelor Programme in Management (IBPM): 2 years minimum of studies in business, ideally in the last year of their bachelor programme (with the equivalent of 120 ECTS credits in Business).
- Master in Management (Grande Ecole Programme): students must have obtained the level "Bachelor Degree" (BA, *Licenciatura*, etc.) plus meet the specific requirements of each programme.
