

Minimum GPA Requirement	None
Minimum <u>English</u> language requirement	None, but it is preferable that those students have a level of English equivalent to IELTS 5.0.
Does TMU accept students with minimum <u>English</u> ?	Yes. Consultation with instructors of each course is necessary before course registration.
Minimum <u>Japanese</u> Language Requirement	None for the SATOMU* program (Courses instructed in English) *SATOMU (Semester Abroad at Tokyo Metropolitan University): http://www.ic.tmu.ac.jp/english/study_abroad/exchange.html Yes, for those who wish to take courses offered in Japanese. It is preferable that those students have a level of Japanese equivalent to the Japanese Language Proficiency Test N1.

Does TMU accept students who do not meet the <u>Japanese</u> language requirement?	Yes, SATOMU program permits students with minimum Japanese to take courses conducted in English. Also, students are strongly recommended to take credit-bearing Japanese language courses provided at 7 levels, starting from the zero level.

E. CLASSES and COURSES

Principle used language	Most classes at TMU are taught in Japanese
Are there any courses not open to exchange students?	Full-time students have registration priority for courses instructed in Japanese. Those who wish to take courses in Japanese need to consult with a course instructor before registration.

Workload/ Completion requirements for exchange students	Exchange students take 7 or 8 courses (about 10 - 14credits depending on the type of courses) per semester. For the immigration purpose (to maintain a full-time student status), students are required to have 10.5 hours of in-class study (7 courses) or research work per week. Completion requirement for SATOMU program participants: 7 credits for each semester (Students are required to earn the set number of credits from courses in English and Japanese language courses.) There is no completion requirement for those taking courses in Japanese.
Self-Assessment for Japanese language course	Mandatory for exchange students at all levels. Self-Assessment sheets will be handed at the orientation.
Length of one period of class	90 minutes (1.5 hours) *Two-credit course usually meets once a week for 90 minutes.
Number of credits per class	2 credits or 1 credit (Japanese language courses and some other courses)
Minimum of credits/course load (if any)	N/A. However, as mentioned above, students need to be in class/research for 10.5 hours or more per week during the semester.
Maximum of credits/course load (if any)	N/A
Course registration period	Within 2 weeks from the first day of class of each semester Registration will be done after arrival at TMU with the help from the International Affairs Office.

* Please note that there are some courses not available to take: Select courses so as not to affect credit points required for your graduation.

* Transcript will be published and sent out to home university by hardcopy approximately one month after the final exam period.

F. Accommodation and living

Accommodation for exchange students	Guaranteed Accommodation will be automatically allocated by TMU.
Types and fees Accessibility to the nearest campus	<p>Global House Chofu (opened in September, 2017) Access: 30 minutes by train to Minami-Osawa Station, the transportation fee is about 10,000 yen per month. Rent: 40,000 yen per month</p> <p>This is a shared apartment with single bedrooms and a common kitchen and shower rooms. Each bed room is equipped with a bed, desk and chair, a closet, and air conditioner. Depending on the situation, the accommodation might be changed.</p> <p>Advance Payment: Admitted students will be asked to pay the accommodation fee for the entire duration of their stay (one semester or two semesters) BEFORE their arrival by wire transfer. Students will be also required to pay the deposit and it is equal to one month's rent. The deposit will be used as room cleaning fee and additional repairing expenses if necessary. After the room inspection, the refundable amount will be determined and return to students by cash at the International Affairs Office.</p>
Check-in dates (Subject to change)	Spring 2018: April 3, 2018 →Check-in date is same as arrival date. Autumn 2018:September 26, 2018→Check-in date is same as arrival date.
Latest Check-out dates	Spring 2018: August 31, 2018 Autumn 2018: February 28, 2019
Notes on housing	Futon mattresses, comforters, pillows and bed linen can be rented or purchased throughout your stay. It is going to be about 10,000 yen to 14,000 yen / set.
Living costs	About 50,000 - 80,000 Japanese yen per month (meals, books, cell-phone prescription fee, transportation, etc. Excluding rent)

G. Others

Airport pick-up service	Available *only for those who arrive on the designated check-in date
Insurance requirement	<p>All international students need to be registered under the National Health Insurance.(Fee: approximately 10,000 Japanese yen per year) All registration and payment procedures will be done after arrival at TMU. It is also advisable to purchase traveler's insurance before coming to Japan.</p>
