- ✓ Korean and English proficiency tests will be required from Fall 2019
- ✓ 1. a copy of the picture page from your passport
- ✓ 2. a current academic transcript (in English)
- 3. a copy of overseas health insurance (in English)

Your insurance policy should cover all and every criteria below;

- 1. Medical Expenses by Accident (Outside of your home country)
- 2. Medical Expenses by Disease (Outside of your home country)
- 3. Medical Evacuation Coverage
- 4. Repatriation of Remains Coverage

STUDENT VISA

exchange student application



receive **Certificate of Admission** by post



apply for **Student Visa** in your country

- 1. Certificate of Admission will be sent to your home university by post after reviewing your application.
- 2. You must obtain an exchange student Visa(D-2-6) to study in Korea. Apply for the Visa at the Korean Embassy (Consulate) in your country.

Do NOT enter Korea with a Tourist Visa. It may cause you a heavy penalty fine.

Pay extra attention if your student Visa is entitled to a **SINGLE ENTRY**. If you visit Korea before the designated arrival dates and go outside of Korea in between, your Single Entry will be expired. Multiple entries will be allowed only after you have applied for an Alien Registration Card in Seoul.



Airport Bus 6013

- Take Airport Bus No. **6013**Bus Stop **5B** at Terminal 1
 Bus Stop **31** at Terminal 2
 the Incheon International
 Airport
- Get off at Sejong
 University Stop (5th stop)
- •Fare KRW 10,000

Taxi

- •Taxi fare is between KRW 80,000-100,000 depending on the traffic
- •Tell the driver you want to go to Sejong University/ 세종대학교(Sejong Daehakkyo in Korean)

Metro

- Take the metro at the Incheon International Airport Stn.
- •Transfer to Line no. 5 at Gongdeok Stn.
- •Transfer to Line no. 7 at Gunja Stn.
- •Get off at Children's Grand Park/Sejong Univ. Stn.
- •Fare KRW 4,500
- 1. We recommend you to take Airport Bus 6013. It is the easiest way to get to Sejong University.
- 2. On your arrival, please directly go to Gwanggaeto Dormitory for check-in.
