| School Fees | Exchange students do not pay tuition to S P Jain. There is a US \$600 (approximate) per semester fee to cover field trips, sports outings, excursions, and other off-campus activities. This is optional for Exchange students. |
| Housing | S P Jain managed housing is available in all three cities (Singapore, Dubai, Sydney) but space is limited. In Singapore, it is located on-campus. In Dubai and Sydney, it is located off-campus about 30 minutes away by bus. Early reservations are encouraged. Off-campus housing may be a more flexible and less costly option for some students. |
| Insurance | Mandatory health and accident insurance is required. |
| Approximate Cost of Living | US\$900 – US\$1,800 per month depending on location and student's lifestyle |
