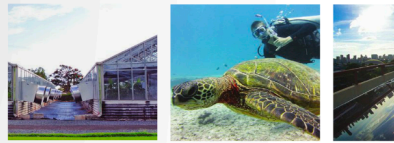

Eligibility	Undergraduate: Minimum 2.5/4.0 GPA required (3.0 for Business); Must have completed at least 24 credits prior to applying OR completed 12 credits and have 12 credits in progress. Graduate: Minimum 3.0/4.0 required.	
English Proficiency	TOEFL iBT 68/ IPT 520 required; 80+/550+ recommended (or IELTS 6.0 required; 6.5+ recommended) Students scoring less than iBT 100/ IPT 600 or IELTS 7.0 must take the ELI placement exam upon arrival and may need to take up to three courses in the ELI.

Estimated Costs	On-campus room & board	\$5,000-\$7,500 per semester including meal plan (varies by residence hall and meal plan selected)
	Off-campus room & meals	\$800-\$1,600 per month rent, plus \$600 per month for food
	Books & class materials	\$500 per semester
	Local transportation	Student fees include a transportation fee for public bus pass (unlimited rides throughout the entire island of O'ahu).
