

Mobile Phone Connection	Basic information: Once you arrive in Turkey, there are three ways you can access mobile phone connection: 1. Through the roaming service which allows you to use your home country's number. 2. Registering the phone you came with from your home country, then buy a simcard in Turkey. The registration costs approximately 140 TL (current price, price changes may apply). If you activate a simcard from a Turkish mobile service provider without registering your phone, it will be blocked after 120 days. 3. Buying a mobile phone and a simcard in Turkey. The simcard costs approximately 25 TL. There are three main carriers for mobile phones from which you can buy your simcard: • Turkcell • Türk Telekom							
Transportation Card	There are various forms of public transport available in İstanbul. The tickets can be purchased at stands next to every station having an average price of 3 Euros for a two-way trip. Weekly and monthly passes are also available at discounted prices for students. istanbul Card istanbul Card is a smart ticket offered by the state body in charge of transportation in İstanbul, İETT. You can use it to pay transportation fee on buses, ships, sea buses, metro and tunnel systems in İstanbul. Having İstanbul Card for student offers up to 50% discount in transportation.
