#### **Some important information:**

- The course list and course contents are available on [www.icheccampus.ichec.be](http://www.icheccampus.ichec.be), in the section “International”, and then in “Incoming students”.
- If you are a total beginner and you wish to take the weekly French course at ICHEC, then you have to take the intensive week of French (or to have had at least 30 hours of French before the start of the semester).
- There is neither a minimum, nor a maximum number of courses/credits to take for ICHEC, but your home university might have other rules.
- Even if you are registered as a Bachelor student in your home university, you can take our Master’s level courses.
- If you are staying at ICHEC only during the fall semester, you can take yearly courses, but you will get only half of the credits for these courses. If you are staying only for the spring semester, you cannot take yearly courses, except for the language courses.
- You can choose courses in English and/or in French.
