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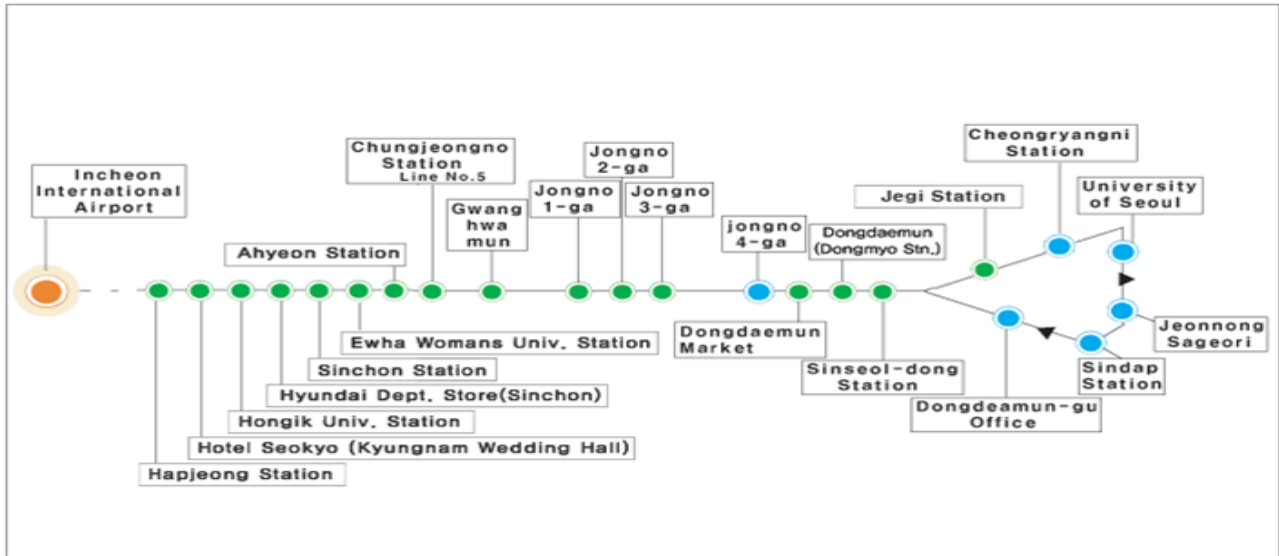

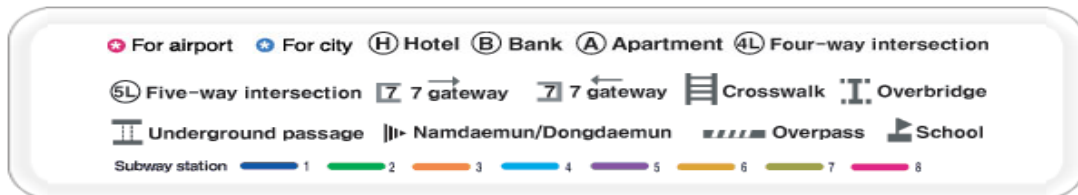

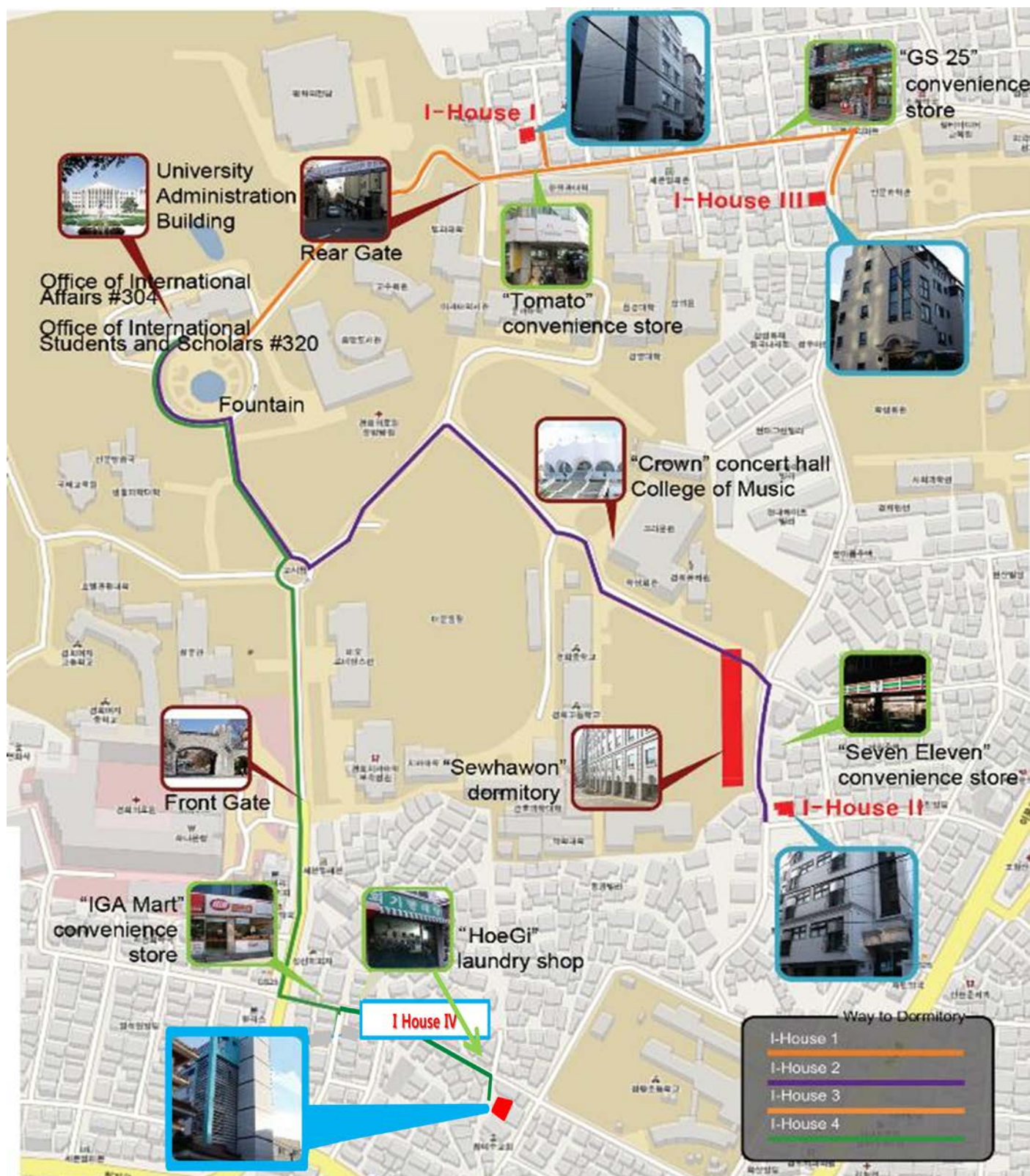

B. I HOUSE 2 location

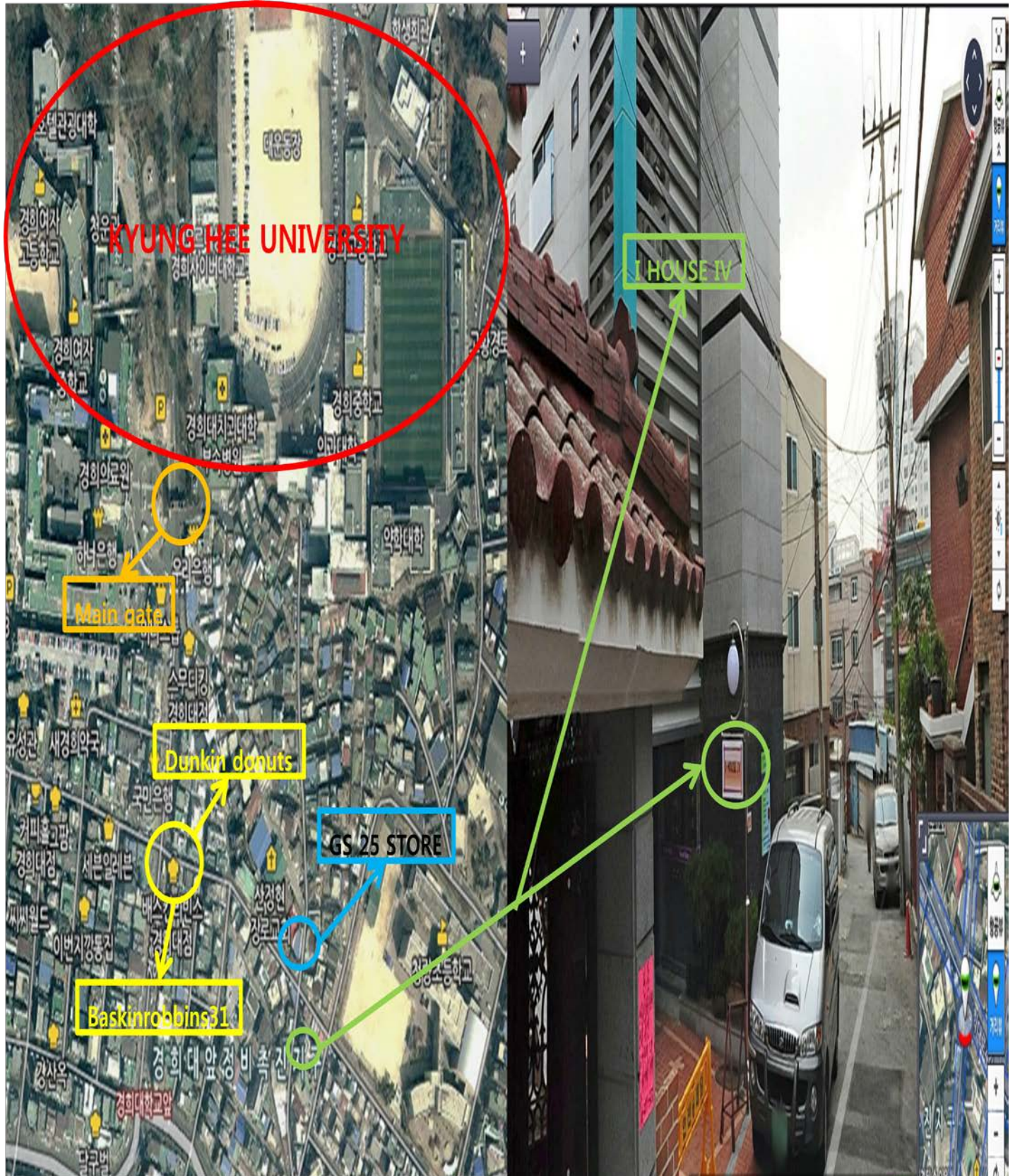
It is placed next to the "Sewha Hall"



C. I HOUSE 4 location

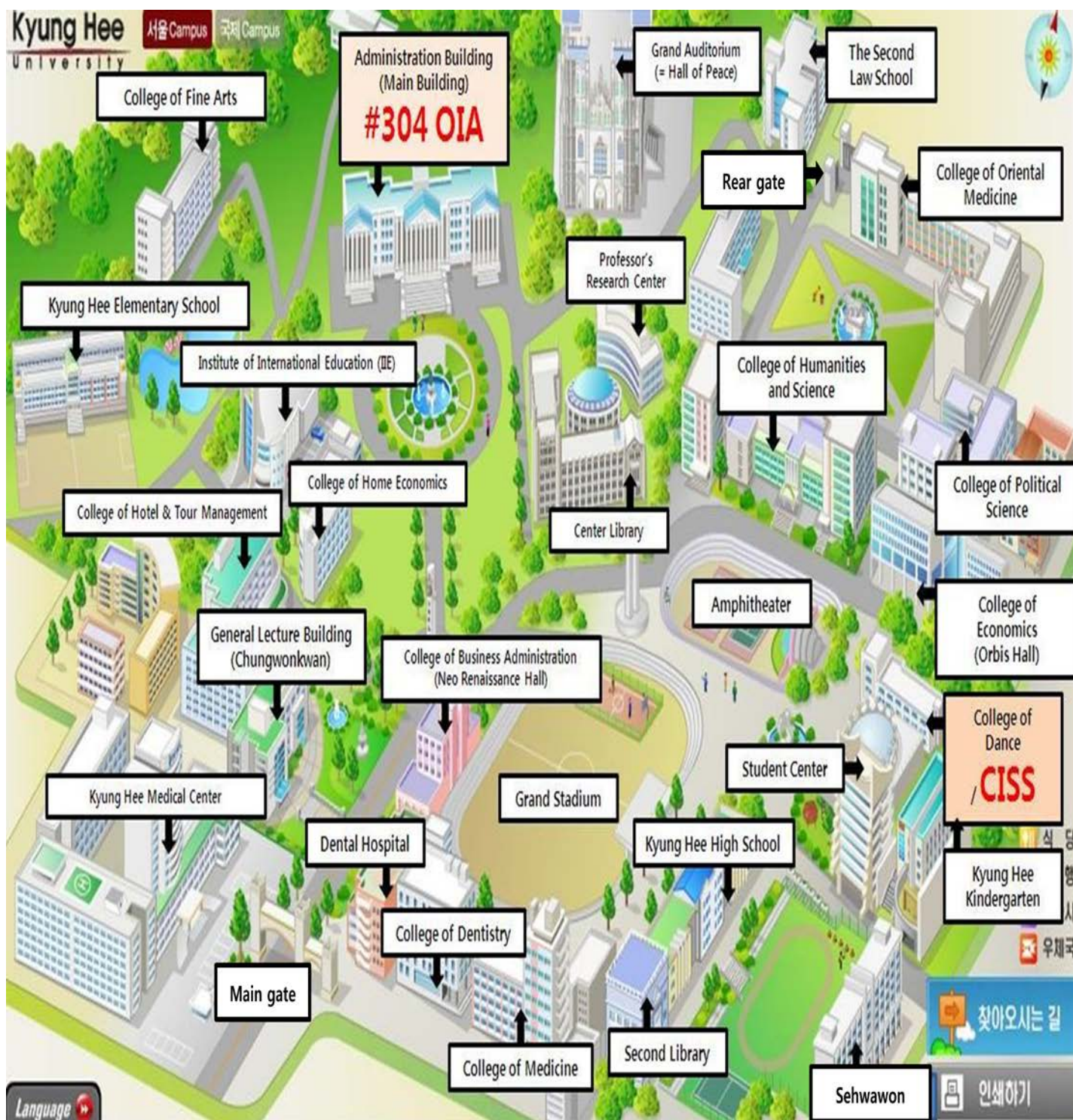
It will take about 5 minutes from I HOUSE IV to Main gate, and Dunkin Donuts.
