Visa information	We submit an Application for Certificate of Eligibility completed by each student to the Immigration Bureau of Japan in Japan to obtain a Certificate of Eligibility for each student. It is usually takes about 1.5-2 months for the certificate to be issued. Once issued, we will send each student the Certificate. It will be around 1-1.5 months prior to the beginning of the intended semester at Kindai University. As soon as you receive the certificate from us, you need to to go the Japanese embassy/consulate near you in your country to apply for a student visa. The processing time is usually around 7-10 days.
