ARRIVAL INFORMATION



Passport

To enter Indonesia, your passport should be valid at least 6 (six) months from the date of entry.

Visas

The Indonesian Government now issues Visa on Arrival and Visa Exemption Facility. Visit https://bit.ly/IDvisajuly22 for more info.

Airport Pick-up

Meeting Point

If you arrive at Terminal 3, you can directly meet your iBuddies at Shihlin Taiwan Street Snacks on Arrival Level. If you arrive at Terminal 1A or 2, you can take SkyTrain (free of charge) to Terminal 3 and reach Shihlin.







You must arrive in Jakarta no later than Saturday, August 20, 2022. You will stay at our BINUS Square Hall of Residence before your flight to Malang.

Provided with a range of facilities like free WiFi, swimming pool, gym, pool table, cafeteria, lounges, and many more.

Flight

Homestay

You will stay in a shared room with one roommate of same gender at one of the community member's house.

Rules

- Smoking is not allowed in the rooms. Please ask the homestay parents about the designated areas for smoking.
- Drinking alcohol is not allowed during the program.
- Drug use is strictly illegal and against the law.
- We strongly suggest you wear conventional outfits. Mini shorts, mini skirts, and tank tops are not socially acceptable.

Water

Please DO NOT drink water from the tap. Tap water in Indonesia is not for drinking purposes. Water can be easily found in any convenience store.

Weather

Jakarta and Malang are HOT and HUMID. Daytime temperature ranges from 31 to 35°C while night time temperature ranges from 20 to 30°C.

Electronic Devices

The standard voltage in Indonesia is 220V. The outlet has two round holes so a two-pronged style should be used.

SIM Card

Getting an Indonesian SIM card is easy and SIM card vendors are easily found in places. Ask your iBuddies for their assistance.

Money

Money exchange booths are located in the airport or malls. If you could be prepared with Indonesian currency before arrival, that would be great!

You can also withdraw money from ATMs that have globally-accepted logos, such as Visa, Master and Cirrus.

Transportation If you want to go exploring Malang in your fee time during the program, the most recommended mode of group transportation is taxi. Taxis can be found and picked up easily on the streets of Malang.
