

## ENTRANCE TEST EXCEPTIONS FOR PROSPECTIVE OFFSHORE FOREIGN STUDENTS

Prospective students with foreign citizenship (WNA) who graduated from an overseas school (Offshore) and have academic qualifications as shown in the table below, can be excluded from the mandatory entrance test (TPKS).
